

CALL FOR ARTIST
Artist in Classroom
Flynn Elementary School
Eau Claire, WI

Introduction:

In Fall 2016, an Artist-in-Classroom (AIC) endowed fund was established with the Eau Claire Public School Foundation by two Eastside Hill patrons for Flynn Elementary School. The purpose of the fund is to provide support for an artist to participate in the art classes for one semester per year to share his/her art, technique with the students and faculty, and give a presentation at an “all school” assembly. The artist will provide one work of his/her art to be displayed and become part of Flynn Elementary School collection.

Dates:

Applications Accepted: April 3, 2017

Application Deadline: September 15, 2017. Only completed applications will be reviewed. Late applications will not be accepted.

Artist Notification: On/about October 16, 2017. Notification will be emailed to the artist.

Application and Process:

The method for selecting the artist will be a “Call for Artist” and the applicants will be reviewed and selected by the art teacher and non-Eau Claire Public School Foundation representative. Together, the art teacher and the artist will determine the activity, hours and schedule for the artist. The selection of the first AIC artist will be for the 2017-2018 academic year. At the present, the interest from the endowment will provide a stipend for one artist in an academic year.

Application Form:

Download and complete the application form.

Statement of Interest:

In 200 words or less, explain your interest in being an AIC, how your work and background prepares you, and what contributions you will make to the program.

Media Description:

In 200 words or less, describe your medium and equipment used. Identify any special provisions that would have to be made to accommodate your media.

Artist Statement:

In 100 words or less, provide an Artist Statement related to your influence and experience.

Artist and Art Criteria:

- Art work must be the original concept of the artist.
- Art work must have been completed within the last four years.
- Art work can be 2 or 3 dimensional.
- Art work must be appropriate for display in the elementary school.

Submitting Digital Images:

Images of art work must be submitted in jpeg format. Four images may be submitted of artist work on a labelled cd or dvd. Images should be labeled **last name_first name_image title_medium**. Jpegs should be no larger than 300 dpi. Images of the artist work must correspond with the listing on the application form.

Application form, statement of interest, artist statement, medium description to be printed and enclosed with the cd or dvd. Mailed to:
